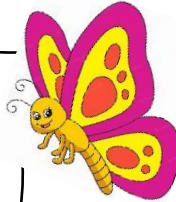

Roam and explore after that.

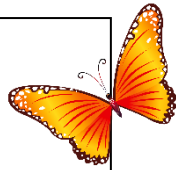
